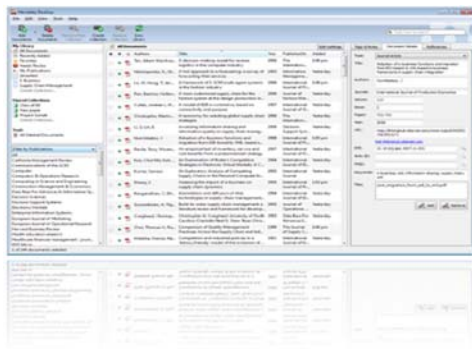

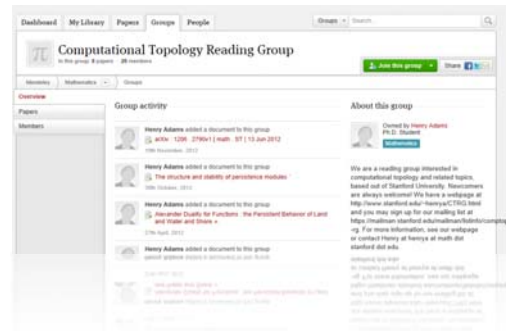

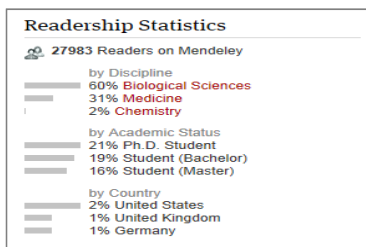
What is Mendeley?

(Windows, Mac, Linux, iOS, Android, Web)

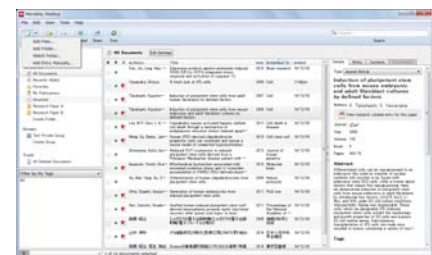
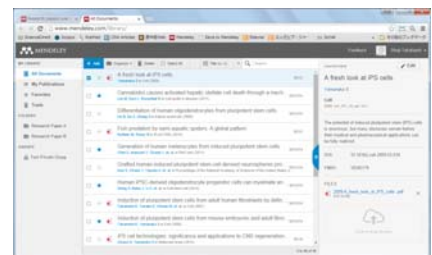
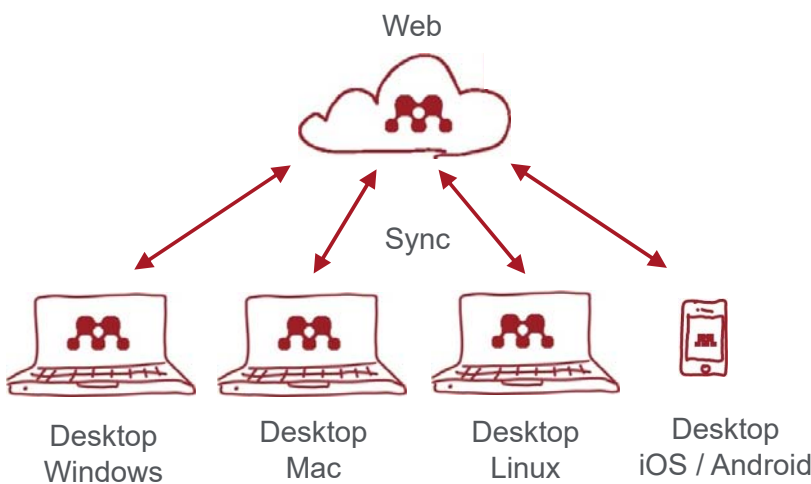

① Importing PDF

- Drag and Drop PDF files into Mendeley

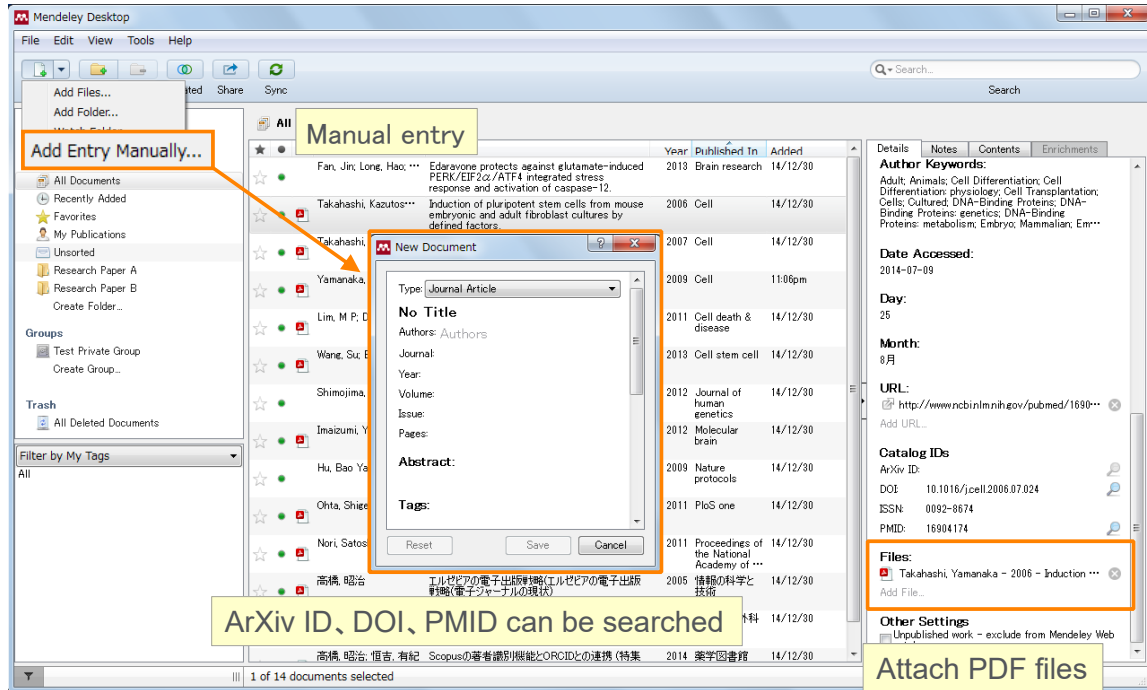

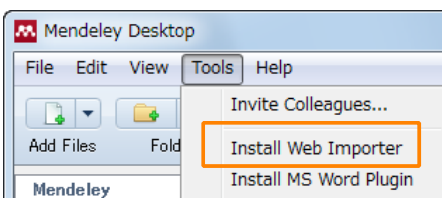

- By using Web Importer, you can import documents from various web databases directly.

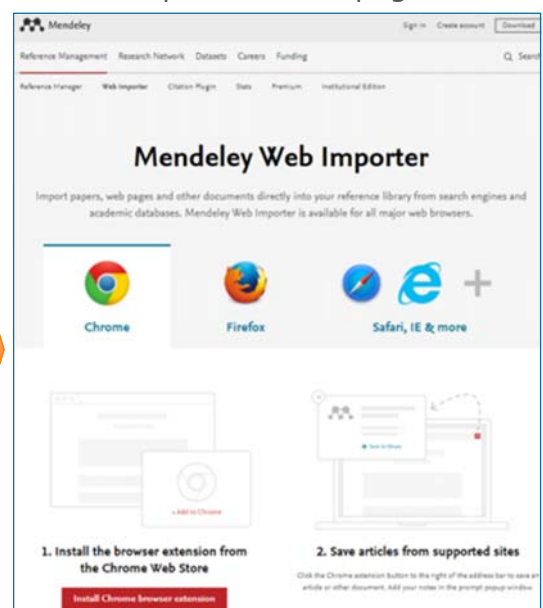

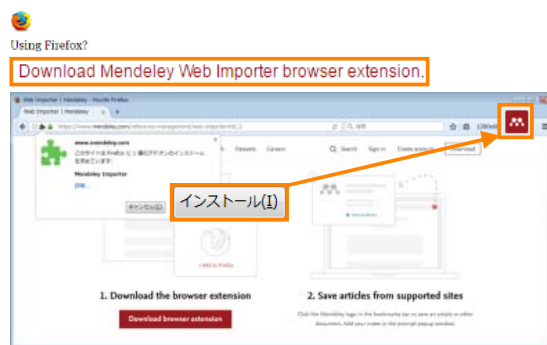
